The following information was compiled utilizing statistic sheets that each lifeguard completes after each public safety contact. The data contained in this document was collected within the date period of **May 26 th 2018 - through – September 3rd 2018**

Duty days (staffed lifeguard services):	<u>85</u>	Number of days with lifeguards on duty.
Surf Rescue Team Response :	<u>49</u>	Specialized aquatic rescue or emergency medical response by the Surf Rescue Team.
Preventative actions (hazard mitigation) :	<u>4,861</u>	Hazards mitigated by ocean lifeguards that would otherwise have ended in possible injury, water rescue or even death.
Surf (water) Rescues:	<u>193</u>	Includes any personal assist or water rescue from within the inshore areas of the Atlantic Ocean.
Minor Medical Aid:	<u>86</u>	Minor injury or illness treated with first aid techniques only.
Major Medical Aid :	<u>24</u>	Injury or illness requiring evaluation or transport by EMS Ambulance. Includes cross staffing ambulance.
Missing/lost Person:	<u>14</u>	Missing child recovered or lost child reunited with parents.
Vessel Boat Assist:	<u>3</u>	Response to a boat in distress
RWC Statistics Ski-1	<b>Rescues</b> <u>4</u>	<b>Preventative Actions</b> <u>64</u>
Lifeguard Training Hours:	<b>100 hours</b>	Ocean rescue and medical response Training hours. Including formal classroom and In-Service Training
