Serving the Bayshore Area July 8-12, 2019

The 9th Jersey Shore Workcamp is ready to receive applications for July 2019. Volunteers from St. John's United Methodist Church and friends will be visiting applicants to access their home improvement needs. There is no financial prerequisite. The only qualifications are the person cannot do the needed work or cannot afford the materials. We are Christians helping our neighbors live safely with dignity and respect.

450 Christian youth and leaders will come to live in a Hazlet school and work on homes in the Bayshore areafree of cost to the homeowners. Each workcamper pays for their mission opportunity. Locally, we raise the funds to supply the paint and building materials needed to work on the homes.

We find the hardest part of our mission is getting the information to elderly and low-income folks who do not subscribe to newspapers or have cable television. We place the applications in township offices, senior centers, service organizations and churches. "Word of mouth" sharing usually works best.

We request that you post the application or print in your newsletter or bulletin. Even if your members do not need the help, they may know of someone in need who could use a wheelchair ramp, painting, new steps or porch replacement.

This is our 15th year and we have serviced an average of 75 to 85 homes each summer. After Hurricane Sandy we held two Workcamps helping 160 homeowners.

Wheelchair Ramps
Weatherization

Limited Roofing (no tear-offs)

(no plumbing or electrical work)

Both labor & materials will be free to qualifying homeowners. (Must own home)
Applications will be carefully reviewed to determine qualification. In order to be considered, please return this application A.S.A.P. no later than February 28, 2019.
