The Council noted that they understood her frustration and would look into a better temporary solution until the road could be repaved.

Acting Chief Robert Burton updated the Borough of the rock incident that occurred the previous month providing additional details. He also informed the Council on the Borough's on the all the things that has been done to increase pedestrian safety including making parts of Linden Avenue a School Zone. He stated that these initiatives counted towards the Borough's NJ Sustainability designation and added that the Borough would be recognized at the State's Easy Ride Champion for Change Award Ceremony.
