RESOLUTION 19-059

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXTENSION OF A CONTRACT FOR SOLID WASTE AND RECYCLABLE MATERIALS COLLECTION FOR A PERIOD OF NINETY (90) DAYS

WHEREAS, by Resolution 2014-60, duly adopted on February 5, 2014, the Borough of Highlands awarded a contract to M&S Waste Service, Inc. for the collection of solid waste and recyclable materials for a term of three (3) years, which contract was subsequently extended for two (2) additional one (1) year periods; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution 18-203, duly adopted on September 20, 2018, the Borough consented to the assignment of the contract for the collection of solid waste and recyclable materials with M&S Waste Services, Inc. to Suburban Disposal, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, the Contract for the collection of solid waste and recyclable materials expires on February 28, 2019; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution 18-222, duly adopted on October 17, 2018, the Borough authorized the advertisement for the receipt of joint bids with the Borough of Sea Bright for solid waste, recyclable materials and bulk collection; and

WHEREAS, Suburban Disposal, Inc. has agreed to continue their service under the present contract for an additional ninety (90) days beyond the expiration date of February 28, 2019, in order to allow proper time for the Borough of Highlands to go out to bid and award a new contract; and

WHEREAS, Suburban Disposal, Inc. will continue to provide solid waste and recyclable materials collection services as described in the bid of its predecessor, M&S Waste Services, for solid waste and recyclable materials and bulk waste for an additional ninety (90) day period at the same rates as are contained in the one (1) year extension option period which expires on February 28, 2019; and

WHEREAS, Suburban Disposal, Inc. will continue to direct solid waste to the Monmouth County Reclamation Center and will continue to direct bulk waste to the Montecalvo Transfer Station to be disposed of at the same rate per ton, as are contained in the one (1) year extension option period which expires on February 28, 2019, for the additional ninety (90) day period; and

WHEREAS, certification of availability of funds has been provided by the Chief Financial Officer.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the governing body of the Borough of Highlands that the present contract with Suburban Disposal, Inc. for the collection of solid

waste and recyclable materials is hereby extended for an additional ninety (90) days, expiring on May 29, 2019.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Borough Administrator be and is hereby authorized to undertake such acts as are reasonable and necessary to accomplish the purposes of this Resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Borough Clerk shall forward a Certified Copy of this Resolution to Suburban Disposal, Inc. and to the Chief Financial Officer of the Borough of Highlands.
