# RESOLUTION 21-179

## A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING TAX SALE WITHOUT DELINQUENT SEWER CHARGES

**WHEREAS**, on October 15, 2020, Governor Murphy issued Executive Order 190 which, among other things, requires that “No gas or electric public or municipal utility or privately or publicly owned water system shall collect any fee or charge imposed for late or otherwise untimely payments or service reconnections that have accrued, and will continue to accrue, during the Public Health Emergency”, and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough of Highlands shall conduct an upcoming tax sale on October 8, 2021; and

**WHEREAS**, the Tax Collector has determined that in order to fully comply with the requirements of Executive Order 190, the Borough should not sell any sewer delinquencies at the October 8, 2021 tax sale.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Borough of Highlands shall proceed with the October 8, 2021 tax sale but shall not sell any sewer delinquencies at said tax sale in order to fully comply with Executive Order 190.
