

Severe Weather and Excessive Rainfall Outlook for THURSDAY

1) Scattered thunderstorms are forecast to develop across the region Thursday afternoon or evening. The Storm Prediction Center has maintained the previous outlook for Thursday, with most of our area at a SLIGHT risk for severe thunderstorms. There is also a MARGINAL risk of excessive rainfall which may lead to flash flooding. While the exact timing and coverage of these threats remain a bit unclear at this time, any thunderstorms will be capable of producing locally damaging winds, hail, and heavy rainfall.



Maximum Forecast Heat Indices for THURSDAY & FRIDAY

2) *Building heat* is expected through Friday with heat indices forecast to reach the 100° to 105°+ range beginning Thursday. Friday is still forecast to be the hottest day of the heat wave, although hot and humid conditions will persist through Saturday. A cold front will bring cooler weather by Sunday. Heat Advisories and an Excessive Heat Watch have been issued for portions of the area. Additional Heat Advisories will likely be needed for Delmarva and far southern New Jersey in future forecast updates.
