Borough Updates

- **HES News** – Students raised \$3,600 for the Kids Heart Challenge www.heart.org/schools. New HVAC will be installed over spring break. Be sure to get tickets for Frozen on 4/19 & 4/20.
- **HHRS News** – The PTO raised \$32,000 for their gift auction fund raiser. Spring sports have started for both Middle and High School. Sports include baseball, softball, track & field and tennis. Go to a game and help root on our Admirals.
- **Emergency Services** – Calls answered: First Aid Squad = 32; Fire = 13; Police = 721
- **Code Enforcement** – Summons = 7; Warnings = 8; Reports = 26; Inspections = 24, Permits = 7; OPRA = 5
- **Building Department** – Inspections = 65; Passed = 58; Failed = 5; Not Ready = 1; Permits issued = 49
- **Department of Public Works [DPW]** – Continue to keep up our parks, beaches and public places.
- **Borough Events** – Please check the Recreation page and highlandsnj.com for event info.
- **Sanitary Sewer Project** – Paving of completed Borough streets will start in the Spring. The remaining work on the county portion of Bay Ave is to finish from Atlantic Street to North and then a small portion near Veterans Park and Bahrs. The county will pave all their roads before school starts in the fall. **Planned for April:** Mains & laterals on Waterwitch between Recreation & Bay and install wells on Bay between Atlantic & North streets.
- **Updates to Vets Park** – Local Recreation grant DCA \$75,000. Work will continue in the Spring. The project includes removing three planting beds at the request of the Garden Club, adding picnic tables, adding water fountain, adding solar lighting, upgrading the basketball courts, and adding a stone checkers/chess table.

Projects Planned for 2024

- **Reconstruction of Bayside Drive & Marie St** – From Shore Dr to Borough border. Work includes storm drainage improvements and paving. DOT grant \$246,850. Delayed until Spring.
- **Marine PI Elevated walkway East [Sea Drift]** – Awarded Monmouth County CDBG grant \$167,647.
- **Shore Drive Pedestrian Safety Improvements** – Sidewalks from Waterwitch to Willow. DOT \$284,000.
- **Create Overlook Park [empty lot on NJSH 36]** – Environmental completed. MCOS \$148k + DCA \$74k.
- **Update Frank Hall Park** – We are submitting a grant request to DCA Local Recreation Improvement in April.
- **Jones Creek** – County will do East section [Snug Harbor]. We resubmitted CAFRA permit 9/2023.

2021 Resiliency Plan Updates

1. **Veteran's Park – Living Shoreline & Bulkhead Combination** - US DOD REPI grant, pre-construction documents submitted. 2. **Snug Harbor Avenue Pump Station** – New Pump Station & 3. **North Street Pump Station Upgrades and Storm Drainage**. Awarded 1.3-million-dollar 2023 NJDOT Local Transportation Projects and 2022 FEMA BRIC, includes updates to current pump stations, a new pump station at Snug Harbor, combining flood mitigation and green infrastructure. Engineering and permitting should be completed in 2024. The entire project is estimated at \$16,205,280 and our grant award is for \$12,193,960, our largest grant ever. 4. **Steel Bulkhead on Marine Place** – Painting water side – Exploring finish options.

Community Rating System [CRS] Update
